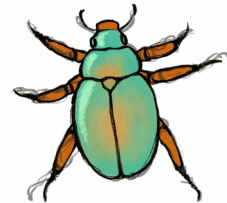

All parents/guardians submitting an entry on behalf of a child must submit their full name, email address, phone number, relationship to child, the child's name and age. Contact information provided will be used for the purpose of notifying the winner of this competition (either by email or written on the back of paper entry)

Terms and Conditions

- Each submission must be an original work
- A child may submit multiple entries
- Any 2D art medium may be used (crayon, markers, coloured pencil, etc.) Please no computer-generated images or 3D materials (glitter, glued items, etc.)
- Words and numbers may be included in the design
- The art competition will run from 11 June 2025 until 2 July, 2025. Entries close at 4pm on 2 July.
- Entries must be completed and submitted to the Glen Street Theatre via email to admin@glenstreet.com.au or in person to the Box Office by 4pm on July 2, 2025 to be considered.
- Open to all children aged 13-years and under - parents and carers please let us know your child's special circumstances on the back of their entry if you wish this to be considered when judging the merits of their entry.
- On submitting an entry, you consent to having the child's first name, age and their artwork appear in publications, on websites and social media for the purposes of the competition and in use in other areas of Glen Street Theatre
- We reserve the right to offer a substitute prize of comparable value if for some reason; the advertised prize is not available.

Judging Criteria

- Judging is far from easy, so we have created some judging guidelines to help make the process fair and consistent. Some of the things we look for are:
- Energy, vitality and evidence you had fun!
- Interesting and beautiful colours
- Mixed media (Pens, pencils, crayon, pasta sauce, collage elements - pretty much anything goes - be as creative as you like)
- The student's age and the effort put in will be taken into account
